Technology

Students in the Core Program have always been required to have internet access and instructor access via email. While the majority of instruction happens in-person, instructors may supplement their teaching with on-line tools to enable students to receive extra help in office hours, tune in on snow days, and interact with instructors in various ways. This blend of in-person instruction with online tools creates a need for video and audio equipment. To this end, we are including two lists: equipment that is required and equipment that could enhance the online learning process for students.

Requirements for completing and turning in assignments

- Computer connected to the internet - used for word processing, internet browsing, and class time Zoom sessions. It should have at least 4 GB of System Memory (RAM)
- Scanning capability– some classes require scanning and uploading of completed assignments. Many printers have the capability to scan a document as a PDF. Cell phones with a scanning app can also be used to scan and send a document as a PDF.

Requirements for instructional help through Zoom

- Computer with internet access to Zoom sessions, or a tablet or phone that will run the Zoom app
- Webcam, microphone, and speakers (these are embedded in many computers, especially laptops)

Enhancements (these are not requirements)

- Earphones with a microphone to block out background noise when participating in online class sessions.
